Please review the Parade Regulations then complete and return this application and the waiver form in order to be considered for participation in the 82nd annual Buc Days NavyArmy Night Parade. Applications **MUST** be completed in full and **MUST** be submitted **no later than April 19, 2019** with any required fees either online at www.bucdays.com or by mail to Buc Days Parade Coordinator, P.O. Box 30404, Corpus Christi, Texas 78463. A written confirmation will be sent if the application is accepted.

DEFINITION: *A miscellaneous unit is any unit other than bands or floats that may consist of marchers, drill teams, athletic groups, horse units, car or mobile units and can include commercial, civic or non-profit organizations. All parade units are charged a \$25 per unit application fee. All commercial units are charged a nonrefundable \$1,000 entry fee. All fees must be submitted with application.* A unit is deemed commercial if the entry is sponsored by, represents or promotes a commercial venture or other for profit entity. Political promotion/advertising is **NOT** allowed.

All entries will be inspected by parade officials on the day of the parade to ensure compliance with the information submitted on the application and with parade regulations and safety requirements.

INCOMPLETE APPLICATION PACKETS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED BY THE PARADE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE. A complete packet consists of a signed Rules and Regulations Form, Application, Waiver and Release Form, picture or sketch of unit and required fee. 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Please familiarize yourself with this information and share it with your parade participants. All entries are subject to inspection by parade officials. Any entry that does not comply with these regulations will be denied participation in the parade or will be subject to expulsion and all fees paid will be forfeited.

• All entries **MUST** be operated in a legal, safe and ethical manner and comply with law enforcement and Bucarader directions and community standards of good taste. **Any lewd, lascivious behavior or profane music will not be tolerated** and will be grounds for expulsion from the parade. **The consumption of drugs or alcohol by parade participants is strictly prohibited.**

• **Advertising or promotion for political candidates or issues is prohibited.** Advertising or promotion for commercial purposes is prohibited on or with any parade unit unless a \$1000 commercial entry fee has been paid. Commercial entries may display only the name of the business/organization submitted on the original entry form. Additional signage, logos, banners, etc. identifying any other business/organization will require an additional \$1000 commercial entry fee to be paid.

• All marchers, walkers, etc., not riding on floats or miscellaneous units, must be at least 14 years of age. All marchers, walkers and riders **MUST** remain with their unit in their assigned position in the staging area and proceed in a steady and continuous manner during the parade, maintaining a minimum of 40 ft. between entries. Bands are allowed to bring a small chase vehicle carrying water and other necessities in the parade.

• All entries **MUST** be highly decorated and illuminated, including tow vehicles: have flame-retardant decorations or other materials and a working and easily accessible fire extinguisher. Smoking in/on units is not permitted. No phones and/or texting by participants is allowed on floats on parade route. No entry may exceed 65 ft. in length or 14 ft. in height.

• All towed entries **MUST** have an approved safety chain between the tow vehicle and the unit/float. All entries **MUST** have sufficient fuel to operate gas-powered generators. Generators should not be started until the parade begins in order to preserve fuel. **DO NOT add fuel to hot generators!**

• All floats and miscellaneous entries **MUST** have easily accessible entrance and exit for participants/riders and a clear, unobstructed view for drivers/operators. Drivers MUST have a valid driver's license and proof of insurance. Convertible vehicles are not allowed except those provided by the Bucaraders for VIPs/dignitaries.

• Objects, such as candy, gum, flowers, samples, coupons, flyers, etc., may NOT be thrown from or otherwise distributed to spectators by any entry or participant.

• Horse units MUST provide a "pooper scooper" to follow the entry to ensure public safety and sanitation.

• In the event of an emergency, vehicle breakdown or equipment failure, entries should be moved promptly away from or off the parade route so as not to impede parade traffic, spectator view or emergency vehicles. **All issues of public safety rest expressly with the Corpus Christi Police Department.**

• All entries **MUST** disperse quickly and safely from the break-up area at the end of the parade route. There will be no "holding area" for floats or miscellaneous units at the end of the parade. Stopping, blocking units behind you from proceeding or unloading participants is NOT permitted until instructed to do so by parade officials.

IN EXCHANGE FOR THE RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EVENT, PARTICIPANT HEREBY WAIVES, RELEASES, AND DISCHARGES ANY AND ALL CLAIMS FOR INJURIES TO PERSON INCLUDING DEATH OR TO PROPERTY THAT PARTICIPANT MAY INCUR AS A RESULT OF PARTICIPANT’S PARTICIPATION IN THE EVENT. THIS RELEASE DISCHARGES THE BC AND ALL OTHER PROMOTERS, SPONSORS, PROMOTING CLUBS, OFFICIALS, AND ANY MUNICIPALITY OR OTHER PUBLIC ENTITY AND THEIR RESPECTIVE AGENTS AND EMPLOYEES (“OTHERS”) ASSOCIATED WITH THE EVENT, AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF OR CONNECTED IN ANY WAY TO THE EVENT, EVEN THOUGH THAT LIABILITY MAY ARISE OUT OF NEGLIGENCE, CARELESSNESS, GROSS NEGLIGENCE OR INTENTIONAL ACT ON THE PART OF **BC OR OTHERS**, OR PARTICIPANTS.

PARTICIPANT UNDERSTANDS AND ACKNOWLEDGES THAT A SERIOUS ACCIDENT CAN OCCUR DURING ACTIVITIES SUCH AS THE EVENT. KNOWING SUCH RISKS, PARTICIPANT HEREBY ASSUMES ALL THOSE RISKS AND INJURY TO PERSON INCLUDING DEATH OR TO PROPERTY RELATED TO EVENT AND RESEASES AND HOLDS HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFIES BC AND OTHERS FOR ANY SUCH INJURY WHETHER SUCH INJURY ARISES FROM BC OR OTHERS’ NEGLIGENCE, CARELESSNESS, GROSS NEGLIGENCE OR INTENTIONAL ACTS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ALL COSTS AND ATTORNEYS FEES.

FURTHER, PARTICIPANT HEREBY GRANTS FULL PERMISSION TO ANY OR ALL OF THE FOREGOING TO USE ANY PHOTOGRAPHS, VIDEOTAPES, MOTION PICTURES, RECORDINGS, OR ANY OTHER RECORD OF THIS EVENT.

PARTICIPANT AGREES THAT THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE SHALL BE BINDING ON PARTICIPANT’S PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVES, HEIRS, ASSIGNS, AND NEXT OF KIN.

PARTICIPANT HAS CAREFULLY READ AND UNDERSTANDS THE FOREGOING WAIVER AND RELEASE AND SIGNS THIS RELEASE AS PARTICIPANT’S OWN FREE ACT.
