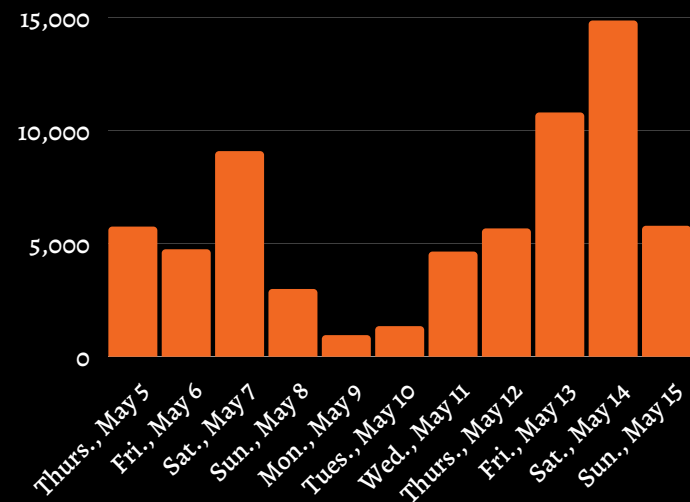


BUC DAYS

Since 1938, the Buccaneer Commission, a non-profit organization, has staged the annual Buccaneer Days festival in Corpus Christi, Texas in support of bringing entertaining, educational and cultural events to the Coastal Bend. Beginning in 1996, proceeds from Buc Days has been awarded to students as college scholarships.

In the spirit and tradition of pirates taking over the City, Corpus Christi Mayor Paulette Guajardo walked the plank of the Red Dragon Pirate Ship to open Buccaneer Days on May 5, 2022.

As I look back on the last four years as Chairman of the Buccaneer Commission, I am grateful to all that support this organization. Since 1938 Buc Days has survived rain events, high winds, World War II and now, during my tenure, a global pandemic. My term as Chairman was therefore stretched from a 3-year to a 4-year term. All our staff, sponsors, partners, and volunteers stayed the course, not only allowing for our Buc Days events to continue through this rough time, but to also allow for the continuation of scholarship growth and giving. We are now over \$1.6 million dollars in giving.

Changes and additions to our Buc Days events occur each year and 2022 was no exception. Our Professional Bull Riding event became host to the two-day championship event, the PBR Velocity Tour Finals. We partnered with First in Texas and CITGO to create a regional robotics competition. The Leadership Program scholarship dollars grew, and a mentoring program was introduced. The Exhibit Hall was transformed into a shopping experience called Treasure Island. All these events complimented our Rodeo, Concerts, BBQ competition, Parades and Carnival. We definitely had something for everyone at Buc Days 2022.

As we look to the future of Buc Days, we are proud to announce that we have taken steps to make the challenge presented in 2018 by our Past Chairman, Pat Horne, to establish a long-term home for our operations a reality. Property with a building was purchased at N. Water Street and Fitzgerald. Construction is ongoing with the Henry Garrett Center's planned opening for early 2023.

Most recently, the organization with the support of the Port of Corpus Christi, has started an endowment that will allow those that have taken part in this century long tradition, a chance to leave their legacy by helping fund scholarships for future generations. Consider investing in the future of the region by supporting this newly established educational fund.

Thank you to all of you for continuing to support the mission of the Buccaneer Commission. We are grateful for each of you.

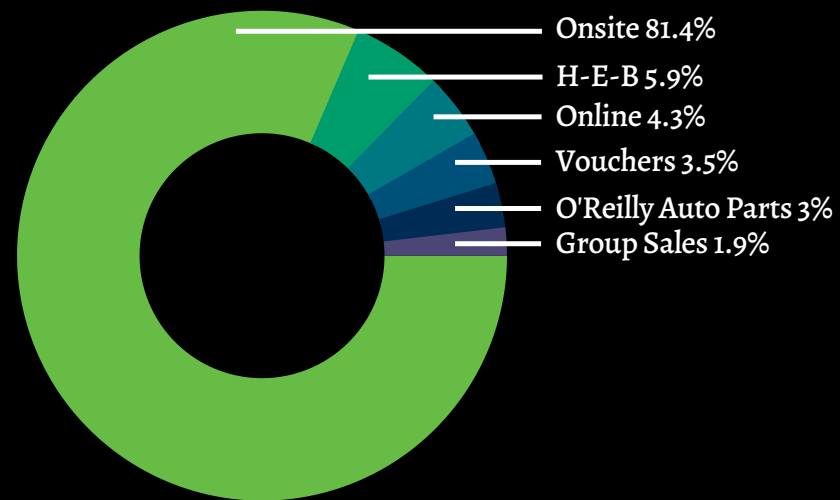

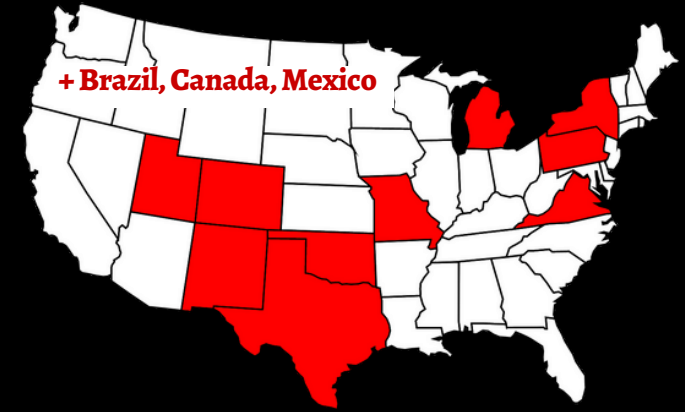


May 6 & 7 | Arena

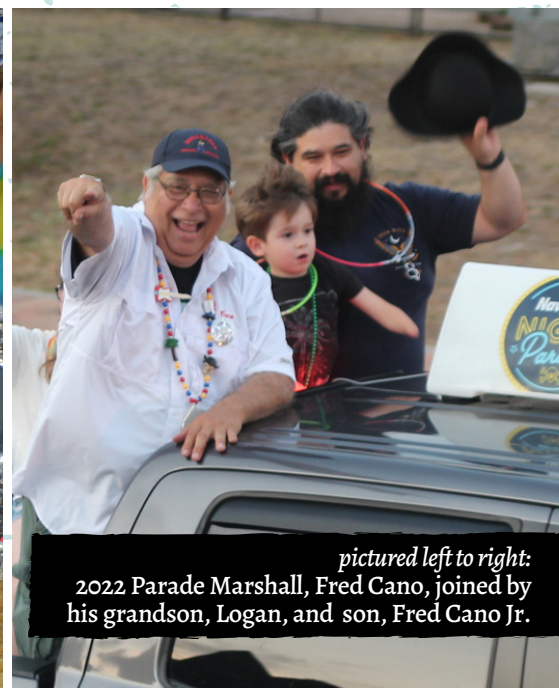

Buc Days reaches far beyond the festival gates these days. As we continue to expand our event offerings to the festival goer, we are also expanding our digital footprint.

Rodeo Corpus Christi was the only Rodeo in North American to be broadcast on network tv (CBS), a cable channel (the Cowboy Channel) and through a streaming service (Pluto TV). The NavyArmy Night Parade continues to receive some of the best ratings in the Saturday evening time slot with the live broadcast carried by KRIS 6 (NBC) locally.

A partnership with US 94.7 Talk & Country allowed for RumpChat, a nationally famous Podcast featuring our Rodeo Clown Justin Rumford, to be broadcast live daily from Brewster Street Icehouse. A Stock Draw was also broadcast live each day from Brewster's at 5pm, where contestants drafted the rodeo stock they'd be riding each night.

Additionally, BucDays.com was overhauled with a new look and easier functionality for the user. Both our website and social media channels continue to grow in reach.

Conservatively, it is estimated that more than 9 million people were reached through our television, radio, website and social media presence.

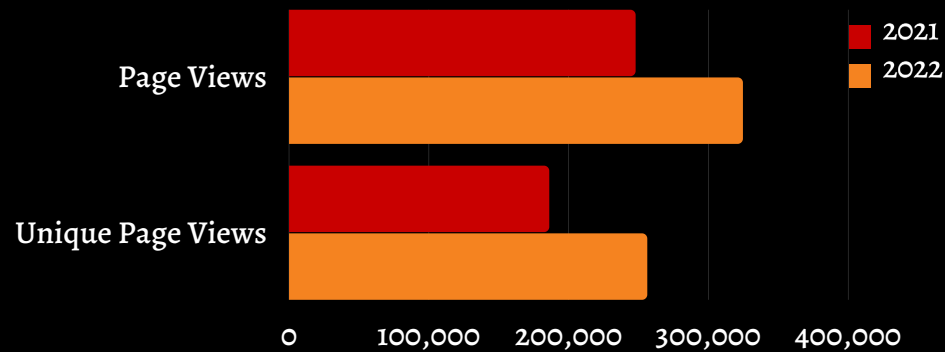

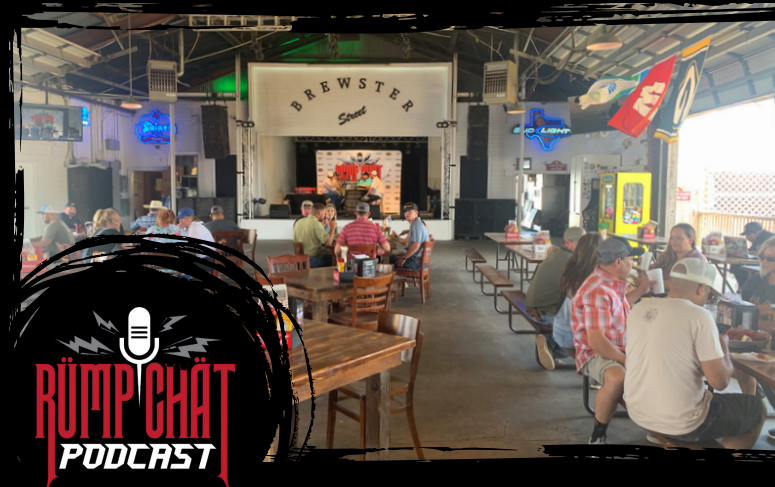

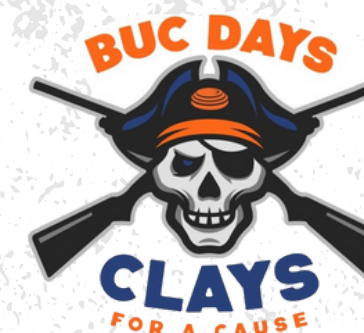

The Buc Days Port of Corpus Christi Leadership Program continues to be a premiere preparatory resource for high school seniors in the Coastal Bend.

In order to expand and evolve the Buc Days Port of Corpus Christi Leadership Program, we were excited to share new changes to our Leadership Program Guidelines and Requirements prior to the 2022 season.

Updates included:

Rebranded the Buc Days Port of Corpus Christi King and Queen Leadership Program to the Buc Days Port of Corpus Christi Leadership Program

Removed the \$10 application fee

First generation-college students received additional points toward final score

Added an attendance point system for training, mentoring and Buc Days events

All scholars that successfully completed the program received an equal scholarship amount of \$3,500, totaling \$70,000

Introduced a Mentoring Program where participants were paired with a Commissioner and/or Volunteer Professional based on career interest. Participants were required to submit a Final Presentation based on their involvement in the program and the outcome of their mentorship experience.

Added an additional \$3,000 scholarship for the student with the highest Final Project score.

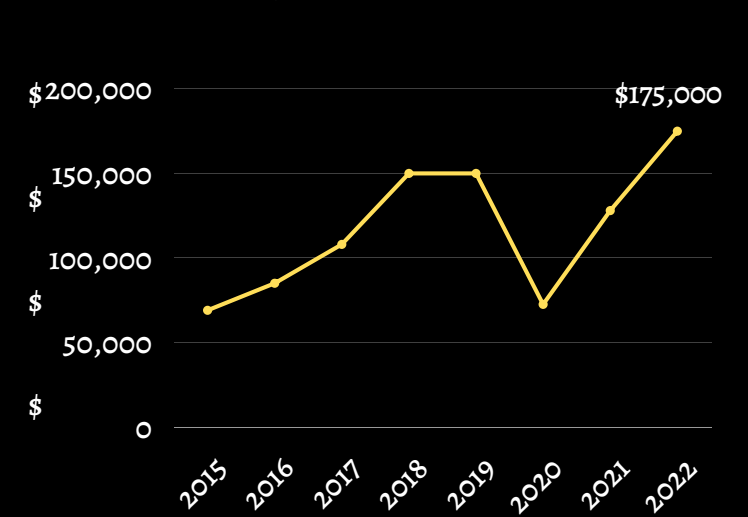

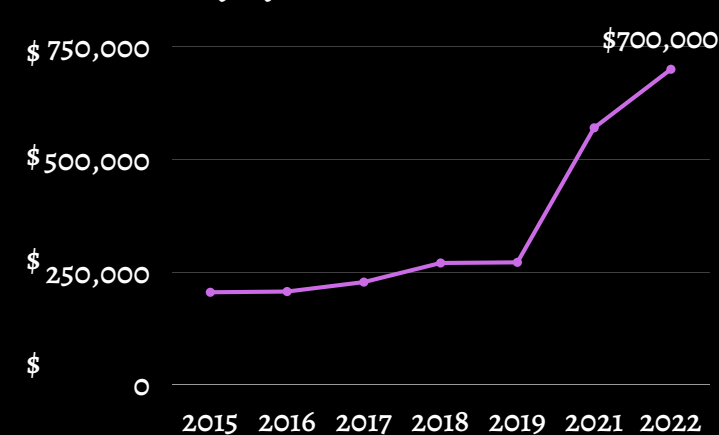
Revenue By Year



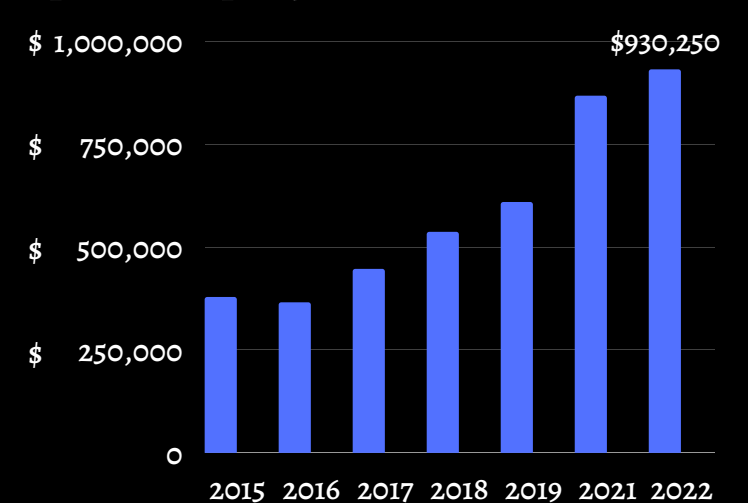
Scholarships by Year

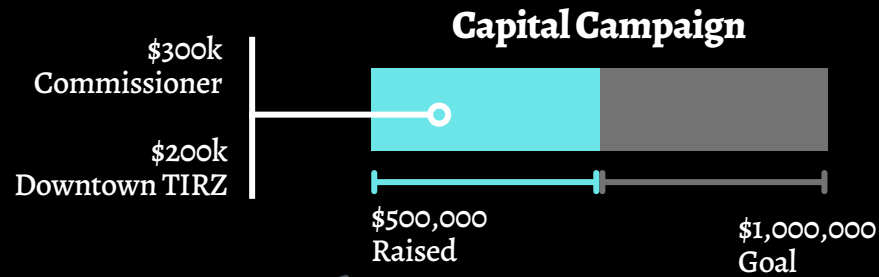
The Buccaneer Commission broke ground on its future home, the Henry Garrett Center on May 10, 2022. Mr. Garrett was recognized and spoke to the Commissioners and elected officials that attended this historic event to pay tribute to his accomplishments.

Phase 1 which will include 5,000 square feet of office space is scheduled to be completed in quarter 1 of 2023. Part of the phase 1 renovation is a new meeting room that will accommodate all Leadership Program meetings, all volunteer/Commission meetings and meetings for other community groups.

An ongoing capital campaign is underway to assist with funding this project for the Buccaneer Commission. To date \$500,000 has been committed via donation and through the downtown tax increment reinvestment zone.

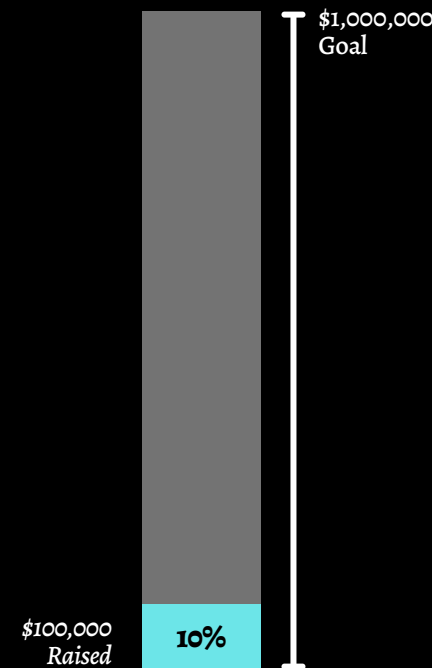
Saving Today to Invest in Tomorrow

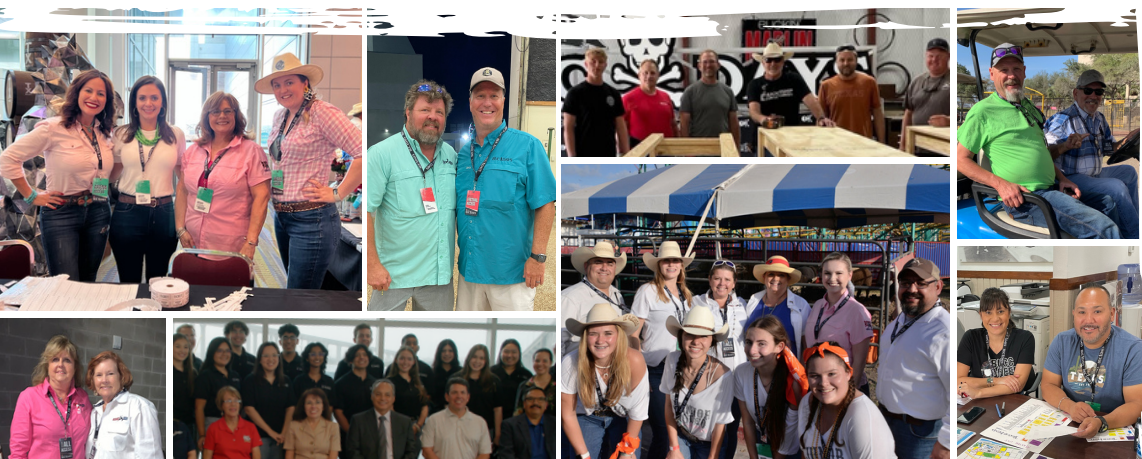
