APRIL 29 - MAY 9, 2021 | AMERICAN BANK CENTER

THE BUCCANEER COMMISSION PROUDLY ANNOUNCED IN JANUARY OF 2020 THAT CITGO HAD COME ABOARD AS THE PRESENTING SPONSOR OF BUCCANEER DAYS 2020. THIS PARTNERSHIP AS WELL AS MANY OTHER CORPORATE PARTNERS THAT PUSHED THEIR SPONSORSHIPS TO 2021 ALLOWED THE BUCCANEER COMMISSION TO PERSEVERE THROUGH THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC.

ON MARCH 15, 2020, AT THE RECOMMENDATION OF CITY LEADERSHIP AND THE CDC, THE BUCCANEER COMMISSION ADHERED TO THE GUIDANCE PROVIDED BY THE CDC TO POSTPONE EVENTS LARGER THAN 50 PEOPLE SO AS TO NOT CONTRIBUTE TO THE SPREAD OF COVID-19. THE HEALTH AND WELL-BEING OF OUR GUESTS, VOLUNTEERS AND PARTICIPANTS WAS OUR TOP PRIORITY AND THEREFORE BUC DAYS WAS POSTPONED UNTIL NOVEMBER 2020. THEN, DUE TO THE CONTINUOUS AND UNEXPECTED SPREAD OF COVID-19, THE BUCCANEER COMMISSION DECIDED TO FURTHER POSTPONE ITS 2020 EVENT UNTIL 2021. THIS DID NOT STOP THE BUCCANEER COMMISSION FROM AWARDING \$62,500 IN 2020.

WE LOOK FORWARD TO DOING IT BIGGER AND BETTER IN 2021."

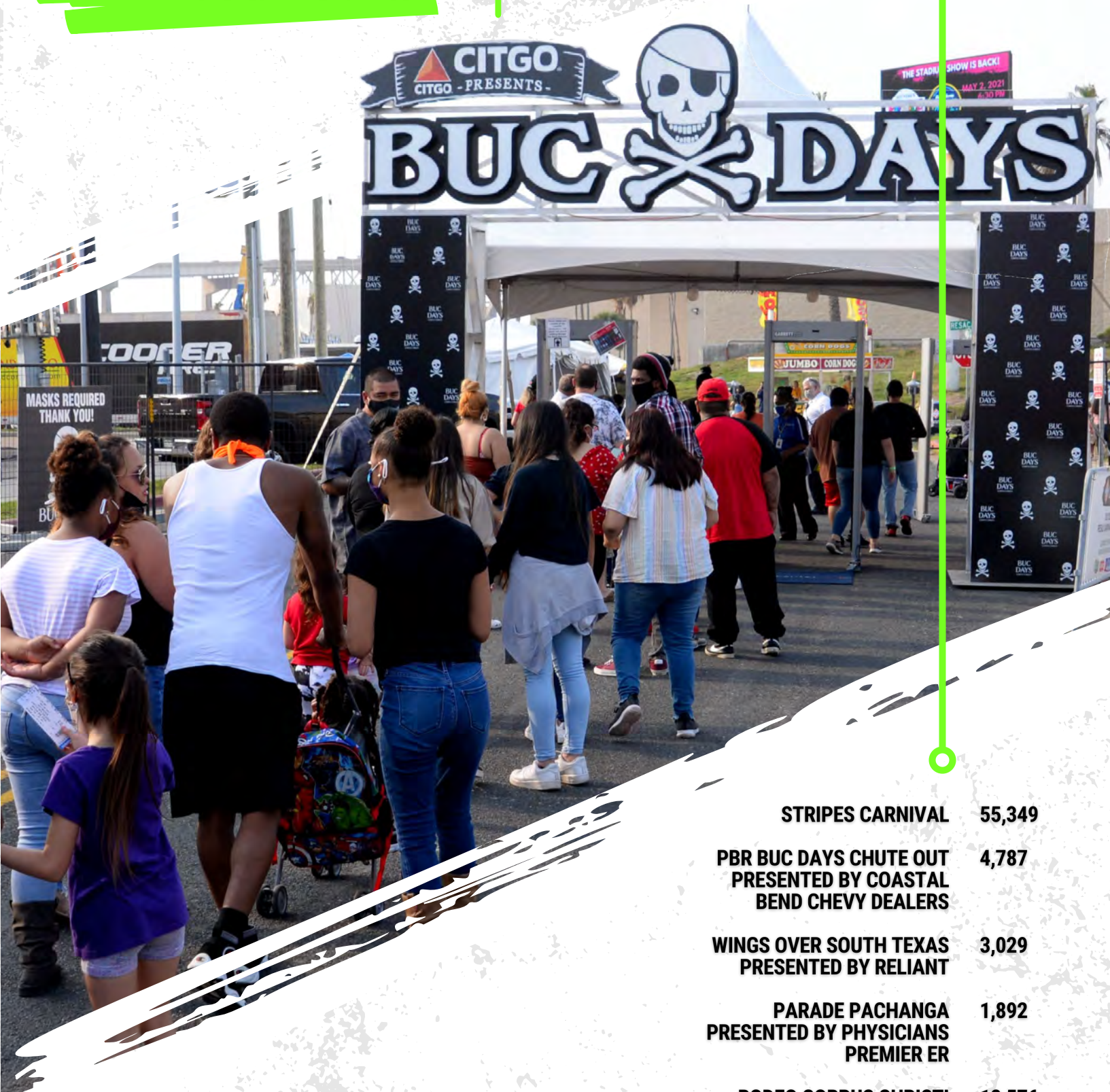

SINCE 1938, THE BUCCANEER COMMISSION, A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, HAS STAGED THE ANNUAL BUCCANEER DAYS FESTIVAL IN CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS IN SUPPORT OF BRINGING ENTERTAINING, EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL EVENTS TO THE COASTAL BEND. BEGINNING IN 1996, PROCEEDS FROM BUC DAYS HAS BEEN AWARDED TO STUDENTS AS COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS.



IT WAS AN ESPECIALLY WONDERFUL SIGHT TO SEE ALL OF YOU THAT CAME OUT TO BUC DAYS 2021. AS YOU MAY KNOW, BUC DAYS 2020 WAS POSTPONED AND THEN CANCELED DUE TO COVID-19. BECAUSE OF THE SUPPORT WE RECEIVED FROM OUR SPONSORS AND VOLUNTEERS, WE WERE ABLE TO NAVIGATE THROUGH THE YEAR AND PRESENT AN EVENT TO THE CITY IN MAY OF 2021.

THE 2021 EVENT LOOKED VERY DIFFERENT THAN PAST YEARS. NEW EVENTS WERE ADDED AND SOME WERE POSTPONED DUE TO OUR COVID-19 MITIGATION PLANS. NEW EVENTS INCLUDED THE WINGS OVER SOUTH TEXAS AIR SHOW AND THE PBR BUC DAYS CHUTE OUT. OTHER CHANGES INCLUDED BECOMING A WCRA RODEO AND SCHEDULING RODEO CORPUS CHRISTI INTO THE SECOND WEEKEND OF OUR 11 DAY EVENT. MISSING FROM THE 2021 EVENT INCLUDED CONCERTS, OUR BBQ ON THE BAY EVENT AND THE NIGHT PARADE 3 MILE MARCH DOWN THE CITY STREETS. ALL THREE OF THESE EVENTS WILL BE RE-INTRODUCED IN 2022 AND WE WILL OFFER YET ANOTHER NEW EVENT, THE TREASURE ISLAND SHOPPING EXPERIENCE.

AS I LOOK BACK AT MY YEARS AS A BUCCANEER COMMISSIONER AND AS THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BUCCANEER COMMISSION BOARD THESE PAST 3 YEARS, I FIND THAT I AM MOST PLEASED WITH THE WAY THE COMMISSION CONTINUES TO BE SUCCESSFUL IN ITS MISSION TO PROVIDE SCHOLARSHIPS YEAR AFTER YEAR. DESPITE A CANCELED EVENT IN 2020, THE COMMISSION AWARDED \$62,500 TO ITS BUC DAYS KING & QUEEN LEADERSHIP PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS. AND ANOTHER \$128,000 HAS BEEN AWARDED THIS YEAR BRINGING OUR GIVING TO OVER \$1.4 MILLION. THANK YOU FOR SUPPORTING OUR EVENT. SO MANY PEOPLE ARE IMPACTED BY YOUR SUPPORT AND WE APPRECIATE EACH OF YOU.

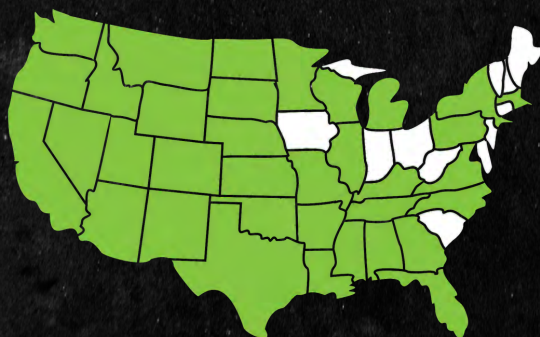

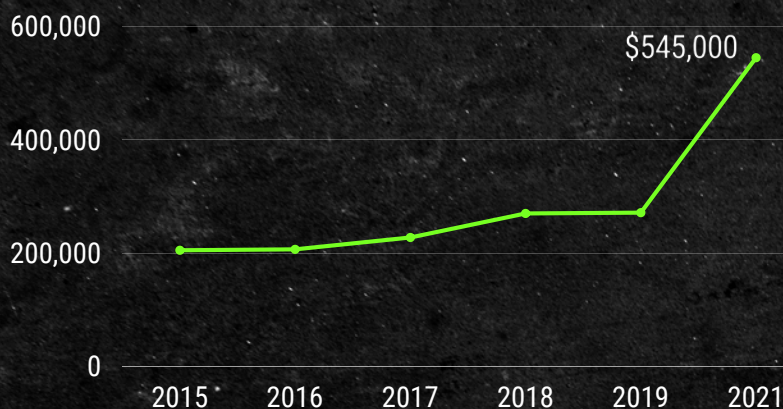

SPONSORS CARRIED FORWARD THEIR FULL COMMITMENTS AND THE CONSUMER WAS READY TO SPEND ON OUR TICKETED EVENTS.

WITH THE HELP OF COVID RELIEF FUNDING AND A VERY STRONG FINANCIAL OUTCOME FROM OUR 2021 EVENT, I AM PROUD TO REPORT THE BUCCANEER COMMISSION IS SOUND FINANCIALLY. THE ORGANIZATION CONTINUES TO BUILD RESERVES FOR A ANOTHER RAINY DAY WHILE ALSO INVESTING IN PROPERTY AND OTHERS ASSETS FOR OUR FUTURE. BUC DAYS IS POSITIONED TO BRING BACK ALL PROGRAMING IN 2022 AND TO CONTINUE FUELING OUR SCHOLARSHIP ENDEAVORS.
